We understand that communication is fundamental, and we are committed to supporting all our young people in

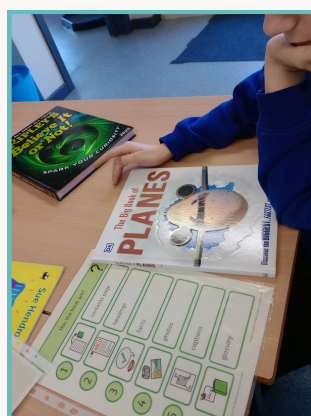

Our Key Stage 2 students have been diving deep into the world of non-fiction texts in their English lessons. They have shown great enthusiasm in demonstrating their understanding of the difference between "real" and "not real" by sorting and identifying the features of non-fiction. It's fantastic to see their critical thinking skills developing! Furthermore, we've been focusing on vital life skills, discussing what to

do in an emergency. Students have learned to distinguish between a problem and an emergency, ensuring they are equipped to respond appropriately in different situations.
